



Child Development Center Fact Sheet

Program Overview

Crittenton Centers' Child Development Center (CDC) offers quality child care and early education services in a family-focused environment. Our full-service day care center offers a nurturing environment where children can learn and grow while they are given a much needed educational head start. To ensure the highest quality services are delivered, the Child Development Center maintains accreditation from the Council on Accreditation and has been deemed by the Excelerate Illinois Program to be a "Silver Circle of Quality" child care center. Additional service enhancements offered in CDC include ongoing developmental assessments and screenings, individualized lesson plans, a parent advisory board, a lending library, parent resources, community garden and walking trail! In addition, we are an Allergy Aware Center.

The Child Development Center serves children ages six weeks to six years old from Peoria and the surrounding communities. With hours from 6:30 am - 6:00 pm, we are able to accommodate most 1st shift work schedules.

Because we believe all families need access to high quality childcare, subsidy payments through the Department of Human Services' Child Care Connection Program are accepted. In FY14, 81% of the families utilizing services qualified for a child-care subsidy through the Department of Human Services. Of the children enrolled, 94% fell into an "at-risk" category based on family factors such as income, parent's education level, single parent home, etc.

FY14 Program Outcomes

- 100% of parents demonstrated an increase in parental skills/knowledge.
- 93% of children demonstrate age appropriate social and academic skills.
- 100% of parents report their children receive a quality early childhood education.
